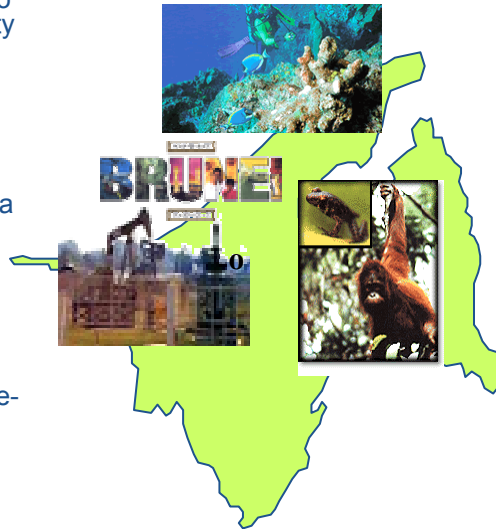
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ICT Economy in 8th National Development Plan

- The main thrust of the 8th National Development Plan is to maintain and improve the quality of life of the people through economic growth, productivity enhancement and wider economic diversification.
- Programs are expected to be geared towards the creation of a sustainable economic growth with emphasis to increase private sector investment from the non-oil-sector.
- 7.21% of 8th NDP allocated for the ICT related programs are: e-Government \$949,340,955 and Brunei Eco-Cyber Park \$170,000,000.

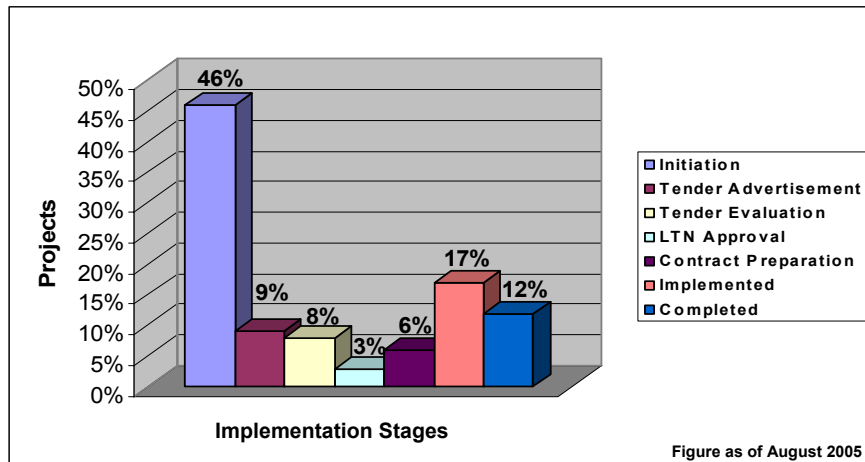
